How to use ssh key for cloudhosting

If you want to use ssh key for login to our ssh environment instead your password, just follow these steps

0. Prepare your public ssh key (for putty example [here](#))
1. login with your password to ssh environment.
2. Create file `~/.ssh/authorized_keys` and put there you public key from step 0. You can use just single command **`mcedit ~/.ssh/authorized_keys`** put there key and close, or if you prefer vim use **`vim ~/.ssh/authorized_keys`**

Don't use `authorized_keys2`. It is generated by our system and will be replace everytime you login.
